### Energy companies seek a trillion rubles to finance Rosseti's projects

According to Kommersant, after a year of discussions, energy companies have yet to reach a consensus on how to close Rosseti's (MOEX: FEES) investment program deficit of over RUB 1 trillion through 2032. These funds are needed for new projects under the General Plan for the Placement of Facilities through 2042. Most market participants are leaning toward continuing to raise transmission tariffs, but this option is being challenged by the Ministry of Economy. Rosseti, however, is awaiting a comprehensive solution.

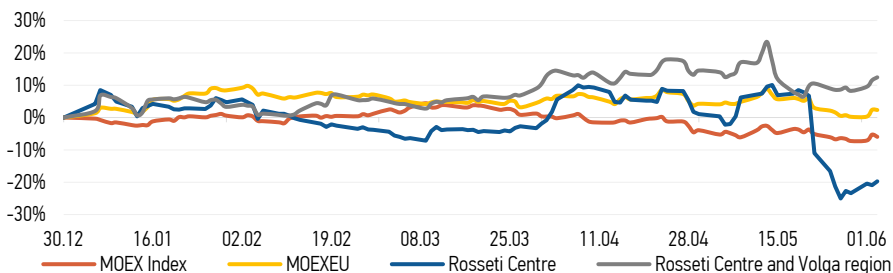
